

Announcement of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand.

No. 1 (2559).

Issued under the Administration Act for Islamic organizations.

B.E.2540

The requirements for terms requesting the use of halal certification logo.

And the use of halal certification logo on the product and packaging. B.E.2559.

By virtue of Section 18 (5) (9) of the Administration of Islamic organizations Act B.E. 2540, and Regulation of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand on the management of Halal Affairs B.E. 2558. The Board of Central Islamic Council of Thailand therefore proclaims the Halal requirements as follows:

1. Scope

- 1.1 This requirement of guidelines to request a permit to use a Halal logo and to mark it on the products and packaging is to be used as a guideline for the use of Halal certificate of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand and it engulfs all Halal packaging and Halal certified products
- 1.2 Halal logo used for certified Halal products by this announcement is subject to the provisions of Islam.
- 1.3 This notification shall apply from the day following the date of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand agreed onwards.
- 1.4 The Central Islamic Council of Thailand acts upon this announcement and has the authority to interpret or judge or command or order to comply with any of this announcement.

2. Reference Documentation

- 2.1 The Regulation of The Central Islamic Council of Thailand on the management of Halal affairs B.E. 2558.
- 2.2 The requirements of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand upon the implementation of entrepreneur certification and product certification and Fees B.E. 2559
- 2.3 The requirements for Halal certification of slaughterhouse and eviscerated parts.
- 2.4 "Halal Products" (Thai Commodity and Food Standards) ACFS. 8400 -2550).
- 2.5 Rules on implementation of entrepreneur certification and product certification and Fees B.E. 2559
- 3. Requests practices certified Halal. And the use of Halal certification mark on the product and packaging.
- 3.1 The products that used Halal logo are allowed only the products that have been audited and given Halal certificate by the Central Islamic Council of Thailand.

- 3.2 The use of the Halal logo on the Halal products on their labels for advertising must comply with regulations of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand, BE 2558, as detailed below.
- 3.2.1 The word Halal written in Arabic that "حلال".
- 3.2.2 The word Halal is identified in a rhombus (diamond square).
- 3.2.3 Behind the frame there are vertical stripes and parallel lines below the rectangle.
- 3.2.4 The named of office of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand is written in Thai, English, Arabic or other languages between parallel lines. (See details of the Regulation of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand: On the management of Halal Affairs B.E. 2558, at the end of this announcement.
- 3.3 The use of Halal products for entrepreneurs which has been endorsed by the Central Islamic Council of Thailand, if entrepreneurs used without permission, they will be prosecuted under consumer protection laws, litigation and intellectual piracy and other crimes, by the approval of the Board of Halal Affairs, or Halal surveillance officer of The Central Islamic Council of Thailand
- 3.4 The use of Halal logo on certified products which must match the documents issued by Office of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand only.
- 3.5 The use of Halal logo on the products with packaging of the same size, raw material, ingredients, and manufacturing process will be regarded as the same product.
- 3.6 From 3.5 if any products are trademarked names are the same, but the size, weight, and packaging are different, and packed into different kinds of bags, packages, bottled and so on. Those will be up to the appropriate consideration of Affairs Halal Department of The Central Islamic Council of Thailand.
- 3.7 Any product used the same trademark name as product certified Halal. That trademark on product that is not certified Halal, or could not be certified as Halal products must be used only on different package distinctly in color and style of packaging. This is to avoid confusion for consumers. The entrepreneur

must be reviewed in conjunction with the packaging design with the Board or their representatives before entering the Halal certification process.

In case the entrepreneur need using packaging or labels that differ from the originally approved by the Board, for Halal certified products, such as packaging or labels on various festivals, promotions and so on, the entrepreneur must file a request to the Halal Board for approval. A fee to use the logo on the events will be specified.

The entrepreneur must specify the duration of the packaging or label of such request to the Board. A contract to use Halal logo will be made. It imposes a fee to use the logo on the packaging label throughout the events temporarily.

Duration 30 days to 90 days, the fee is 100 baht.

Duration 91 days up to 120 days, the fee is 200 baht.

Duration 121 days or more, the fee is 300 baht.

However the entrepreneurs must pay a fee as prescribed, but may be based on consideration of the Halal affairs department of Central Islamic Council of Thailand depending on the difference of the label.

- 3.8 If the entrepreneurs would like to use the Halal logo in the same code of Halal products different because of the cut or trim such as meat cut or trim to separate parts for distributors such as chest, thigh, wing, neck, this will be endorsed in separate item. See Fees for certifying Halal products Article 4 of this rule. The Halal Affairs department may consider issuing a special code for the entrepreneurs on consideration of the Halal affairs department of Central Islamic Council of Thailand only.
- 3.9 In cases the entrepreneurs need certifying only Halal slaughtering of animals in accordance with the provisions of Islam. It will be considered as one certified product. And this will be given the certificate and the code only for Halal slaughtering.
- 3.10 9 In cases the entrepreneurs have products with the same characteristics as components, compounds, raw materials and production processes, but the

entrepreneurs wish to use a different name for business purposes, they must ask for those products separately.

- 3.11 In cases the Halal entrepreneur or supplier wants the Halal logo displaying on a billboard or in a retail location for the exhibition, on vehicles or dealer car, this is not allowed and is considered as a violation.
- 3.12 From the case of 3.11, if an entrepreneur of Halal products wants the Halal logo to be as media of advertisement. The entrepreneur must ensure that food and all other products sold must be certified Halal and must be licensed only by the Department of Halal Affairs, the Central Islamic Council of Thailand in written note before being implemented.
- 3.13 If the entrepreneur is a representative manufacturing or OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer / House Brand (Own Brand Department) that manufactured and sold. The employer of those certified Halal products will be responsible to the Board or have joint responsibility to the Board in Halal certification process control of products by paying fee for certification and certificate of using Halal logo, according to the regulations of the Central Islamic Council of Thailand regarding the implementation of entrepreneur certification and product certification and fees B.E.2559. And will be filed with the additional documentation requested below.
- Documents of registered trademarks or trademarks desired for products requested to be certified Halal.
- If use the power of attorney, it must be authorized in writing.
- An audit of manufacturing plant, the production location is first considered.
- If the employer is a foreign entrepreneur then the manufacturer (the maker) is responsible for the fee or other costs related to certification.
- If the employer is a foreign entrepreneur, then the manufacturer must list the documents of the employer report the Halal Affairs department.
- It is not allowed for the supplier (employer) to use the certificate, logo, and Halal code of the manufacturer in all cases.

- In this case authorized staff should review the documents provided with clear confirmation.
- 3:14 Entrepreneurs who want to use the Halal logo on the Halal certified product must specify size of logo and code number on packaging, so that consumers can see it clearly, the entrepreneurs must arrange the size of the package appropriately
- 3.15 If the entrepreneurs producing finished food (ready to eat) by packaging Halal food products together with other uncertified food the entrepreneurs have to register that packaging as a separate item of Halal product. And it is not allowed using code number of products included in the box attach to the packaging. And the entrepreneur must ensure that all the products in the packet are only Halal products.
- 3.16 If the entrepreneurs let a subcontractor do packaging process or any process that others do instead, entrepreneurs must control the process. That contractor must ask for Halal certification, according to the regulation of Central Islamic Council of Thailand.
- 3.17 It does not allow entrepreneurs certified Halal bringing the number of their Halal certified establishments attach to the packaging or product. Since every Halal product has its own Halal code number issued by the office of Central Islamic Council of Thailand. In case the entrepreneurs have a variety of Halal products in package, it is allowed to use the Halal establishment number attach to the packaging. But this allowing must be approved by Halal Affairs department, The Central Islamic Council of Thailand, before continuing.
- 3.18 The entrepreneurs who lack certification, renewal or cancellation request certified Halal, entrepreneurs need to collect products that are Halal certified out of the market within 90 days from the date of expiry or since the confirmation of cancellation, or upon the approval of the Halal Affairs department, The Central Islamic Council of Thailand.
- 3.19 If the entrepreneur cancels Halal certification or does not have Halal certification renewal scheduled. He cannot use the packaging has the logo with the halal certification on the product; otherwise, it will be considered Halal logo violation.

- 3.20 The entrepreneurs importing products or product ingredients from abroad for Halal certification, the imported materials are considered dividing into 13 groups as following.
- 1. Flavor from the plant.
- 2. Flavor from animal.
- 3. Plant Extracts
- 4. Animal Extract
- 5. Synthetic and natural food coloring
- 6. Chemical stabilizer
- 7. Preservatives (Anti-oxidants)
- 8. Cleaner and disinfectants
- 9. Enzymes, microorganisms.
- 10. Milk and milk products
- 11. Vitamins, minerals
- 12. Drugs
- 13. Others
- 3.21 If the entrepreneur purchases raw imported materials or ingredients from domestic suppliers, and those raw materials or, ingredients are not certified Halal from abroad, such as chemical synthesis or other extracts and The Board considers that there is no risk from haram sources, or any harmful effects on the production process, especially the products used in households, in cosmetics, and in neutraceuticals, the Board may consider giving preliminary approval Halal certificate, provided that the renewal of Halal certification in the future needs to provide proof of Halal certification in such materials.
- 3:22 The case of the entrepreneur in 3:21 could request Halal certification of raw materials that were not certified Halal before is the case of the

entrepreneur who produces household goods, the cosmetics or dietary supplements, imports raw materials without Halal certification from abroad, and imports directly (not through a domestic distributor) the entrepreneur of products mentioned above can file request to the Board as an entrepreneur in category 'raw materials importer' according to Board's conditions and regulations related

In case the entrepreneur of manufacturing of cosmetics products or supplements imports raw materials that are not certified Halal though the distributor in the country, the entrepreneur can ask distributors to file petition the Board to certify Halal for their imported raw materials according to Board's conditions and regulations related

4. Fees for certifying Halal products.

Halal Products means natural products or manufactured products according to the procedure of Halal standards. This includes the sale, the advertising, the services, public relations, logistics and innovation which are not against provisions of Islam. (CICOT regulation, on the management of Halal Affairs B.E. 2558. Section 1) the details of Halal fee are classified as follows.

4.1 Finished food products ready to consume.

Fee 500 THB / item

- 4.2 Cooked food for services (other than Halal kitchen) on the bus, couch, aircraft, trains, etc.). Fee 100 THB / item
- 4.3 Products, raw materials, ingredients, components (non-imports).

Fee 100 THB / item

- 4.4 Imported finished products and ready to eat food. Fee 500 THB / item
- 4.5 Products imported such as raw materials, ingredients, components (divided into 13 groups in case 3.20). Fee 500 baht / group
- 4.6 Halal Kitchens. Fee 500 baht/location

4.7 Butchered animal products, selling as a whole animal. Fee 500 baht

The products of dissected pieces of poultry. Fee is as listed below.

1. Dissected parts (named part)	Fee for 500 baht
2. Breasts	Fee for 500 baht
3. Calf	Fee 500 baht.
4. Hip	Fee 500 baht
5. Calf hip	Fee 500 baht.
6. Wings and wing parts	Fee 500 baht
7. Chicken ass	Fees 500 baht.
8. Leg and part of leg.	Fee 500 baht
9. Chicken fats / chicken skin	Fee 500 baht.
9. Chicken fats / chicken skin10. Meat scraps / grinded meat	
	Fee 500 baht.
10. Meat scraps / grinded meat	Fee 500 baht. Fee 500 baht.
10. Meat scraps / grinded meat11. Head and neck	Fee 500 baht. Fee 500 baht. Fee 500 baht.

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The Halal code may be allowed to use only one single code for dissected parts, it depends on the approval of the Halal Affairs department. The payment of fee will be on the basis that is 500 baht per item. If the name of poultry products is added for marketing reasons or business, registration must be also added for Halal additional items, the fee is 500 baht per item.

If a piece of meat or offal or gut of cattle, goats and sheep, consider a product.

1. Meat / meat pieces Fee 500 baht

2. Parts of gut Fee 500 baht

3. Other parts Fee 500 baht.

If a piece of meat or offal uses specific name of product for marketing reasons or business, it must be registered as a new Halal product. The fee is 500 baht/new product.
